

## Manual - „Obtain an IP address automatically“

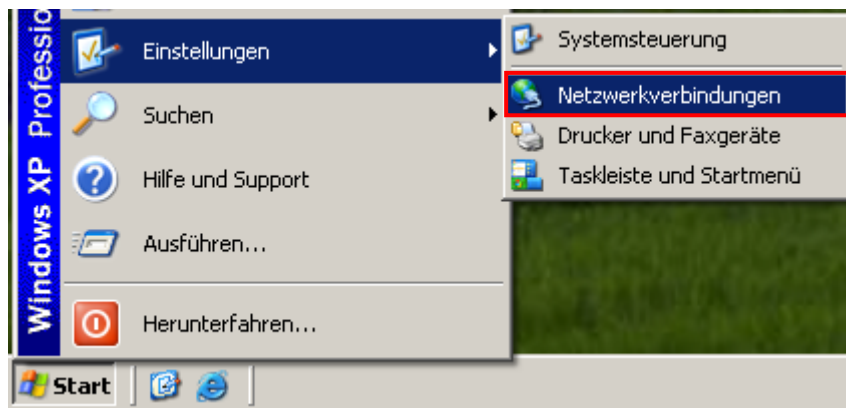
In order of the exchange of the new system on **03.08.09**, the IP-addresses will be acquired automatically. The following guides will show you, where and which settings you have to change:

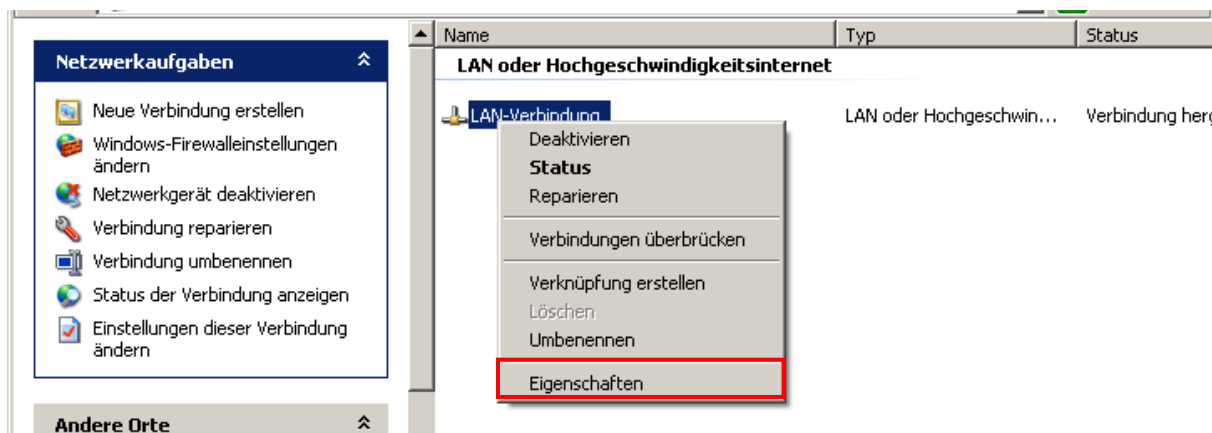
### Windows XP

#### Step 1

- Start -> Control Panel -> Network Connections.

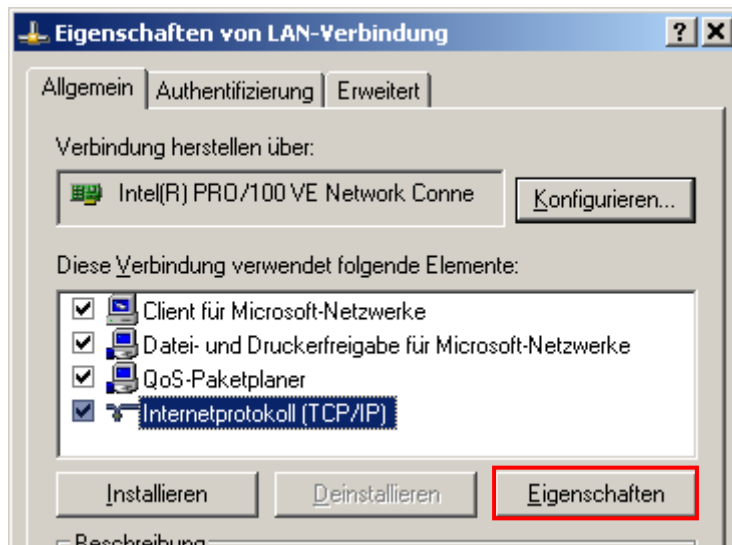


- „right click“ on Local Area Connection and select „Properties“.



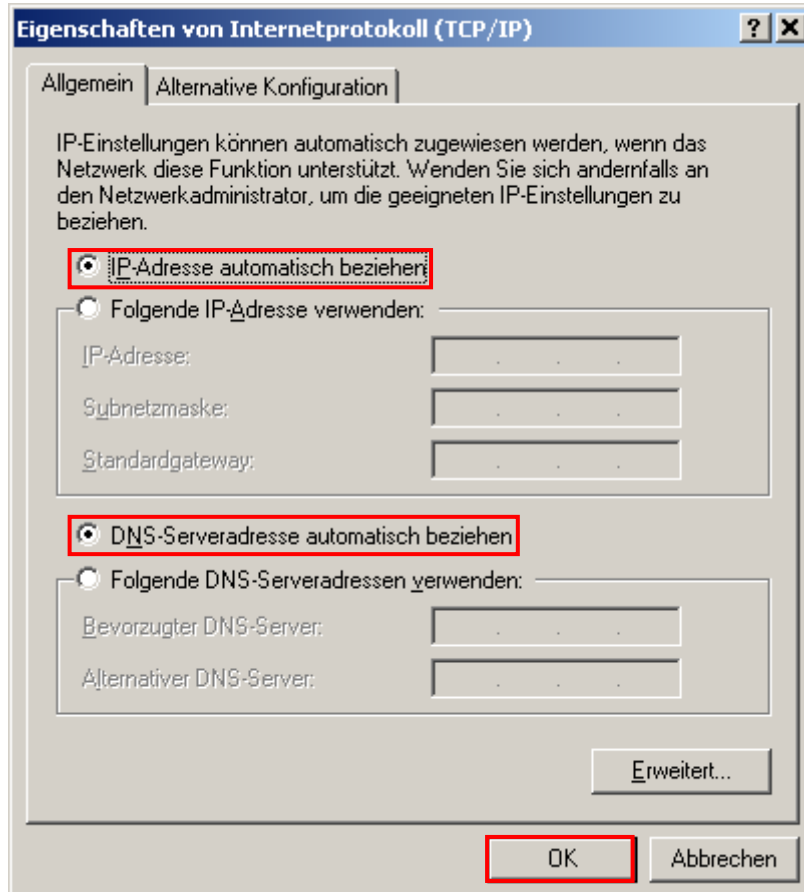
**Step 2**

- Choose the register „General“ -> „Internet Protocol (TCP/IP)“ and then click on „Properties“.



**Step 3**

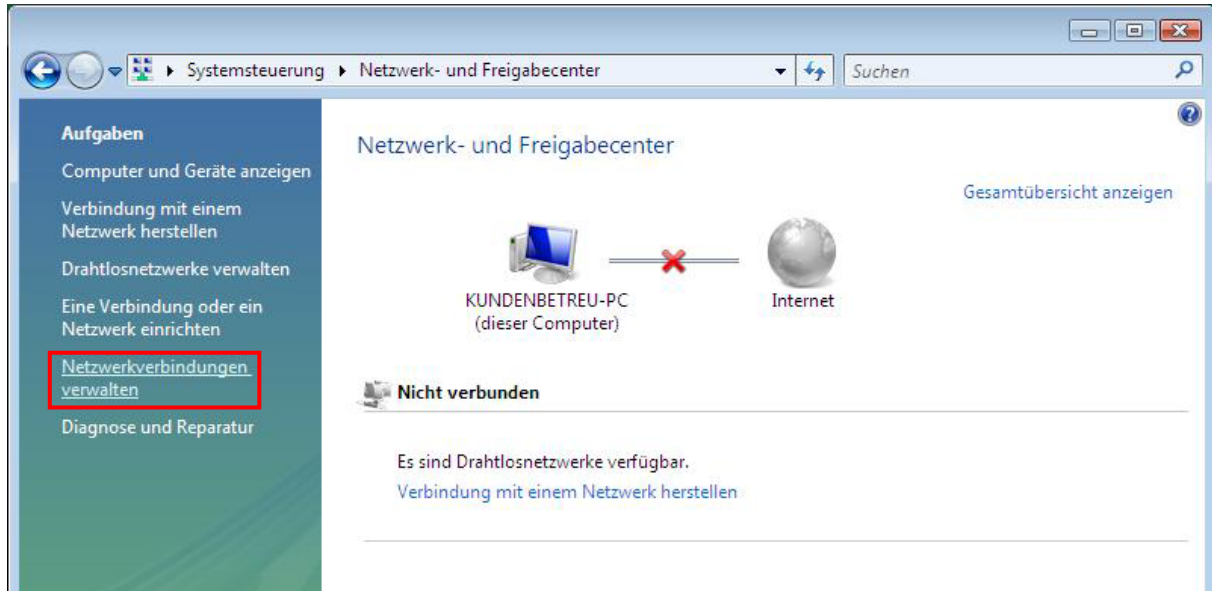
- In the register „General“ select the field „Obtain an IP address automatically“ & „Obtain DNS server address automatically“ and confirm with „OK“.



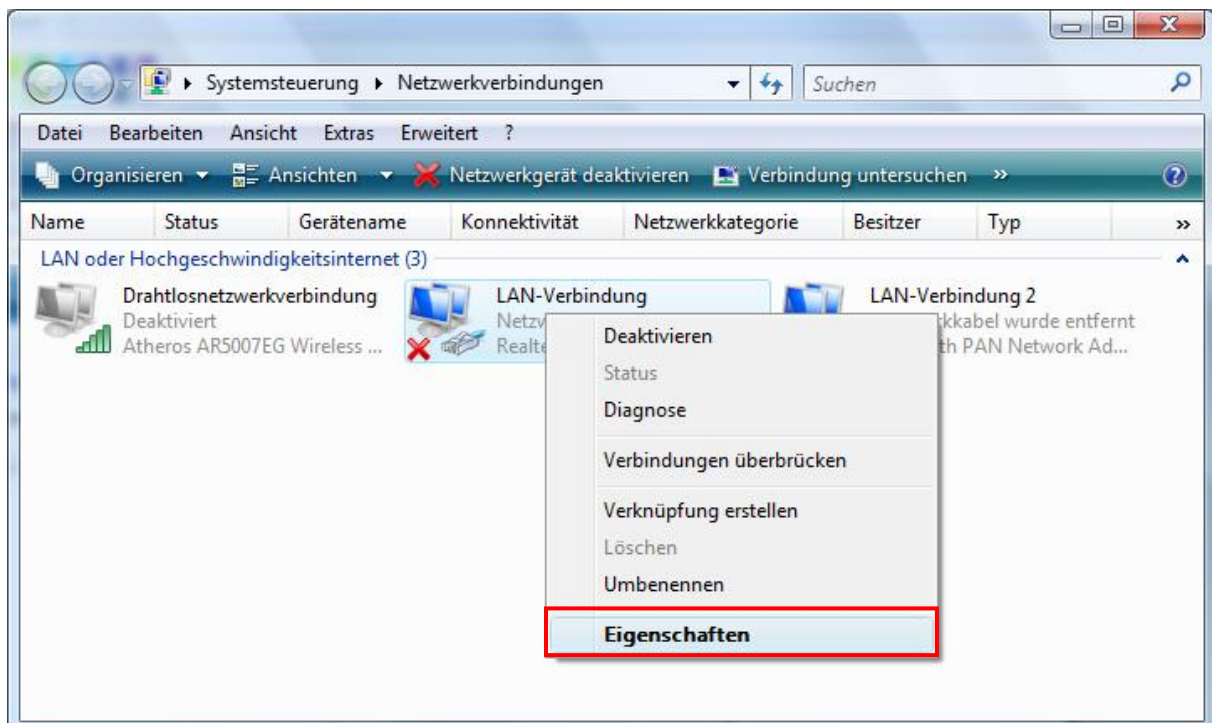
## Windows Vista

### Step 1

- Start -> Control Panel -> Network and Sharing Center -> Manage Network Connections.

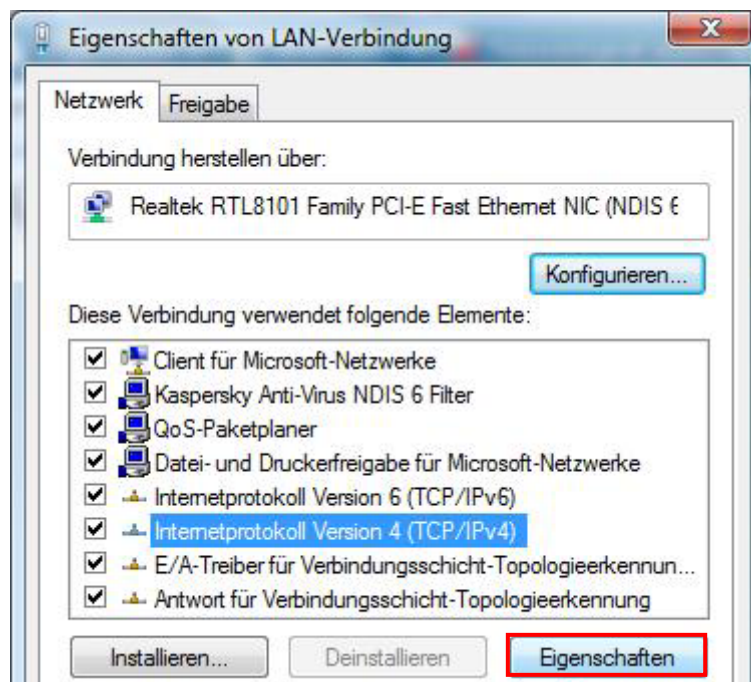


- „right click“ on Local Area Connection and then click on „Properties“.



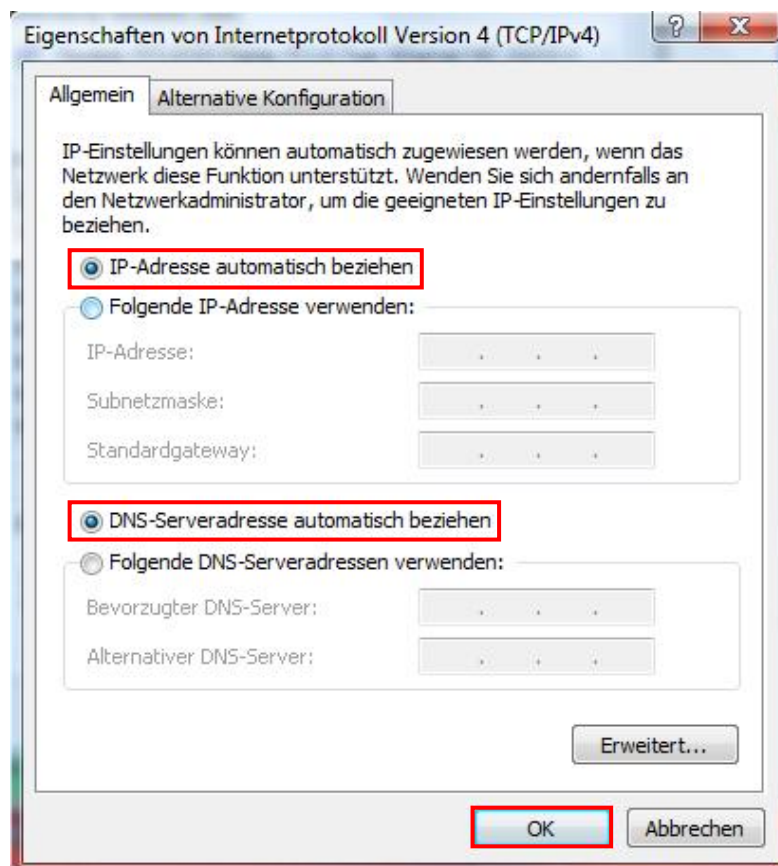
**Step 2**

- In the register „Networking“ select the field „Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP/IPv4)“ and then click on „Properties“.



**Step 3**

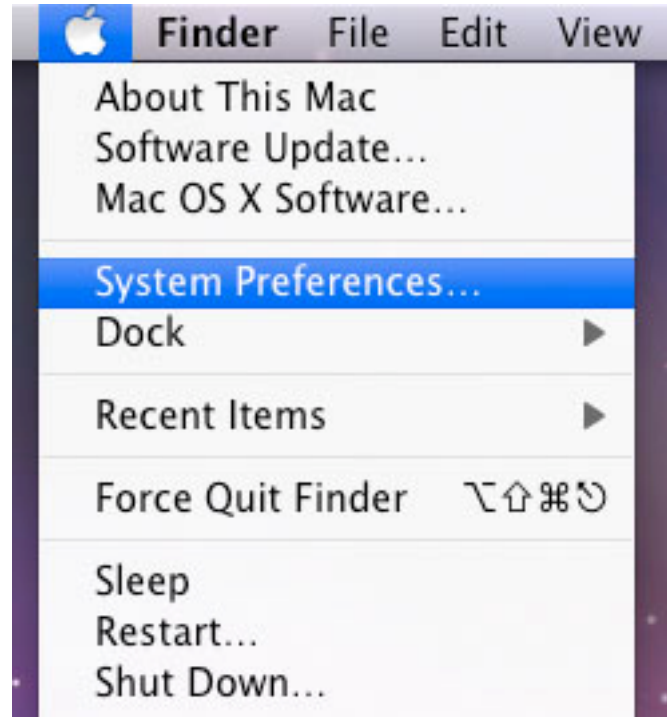
- In the register „General“ select the field „Obtain an IP address automatically“ & „Obtain DNS server address automatically“ and confirm with „OK“.



## Mac OS X

### Step 1

- „Apple-Menu“ -> „System Preferences“



### Step 2

- In „System Preferences“ click on the Icon „Network“.

- At the Ethernet connection, change the option „Configure“ to „Using DHCP“ and apply with a click on “Apply”
